### ***Not Accredited***

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#### **July 2015 Update**

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The CAAM-HP at its meeting held July 23-25, 2014 noted the report of efforts being made to address the issues in the letter of July 28, 2014 and in particular the appointment of a new dean. The meeting noted that there was a number of critical areas outlined in the aforementioned letter that still needed to be addressed and strongly recommended the appointment of a senior physician in the school's administration. CAAM-HP looks forward to the full site visit in 2016.

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#### **July 2014 Determination: *Not Accredited***

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It has been brought to the attention of the CAAM-HP Secretariat that reports have been circulating that Windsor University School of Medicine in St Kitts has been accredited or provisionally accredited by CAAM-HP. The CAAM-HP wishes to advise that Windsor University School of Medicine is not accredited by the CAAM-HP. The site visit took place in March 2014 and, after consideration of the site visit report, CAAM-HP in July 2014 determined that it could not accord accreditation to the programme. The school was asked to reapply for accreditation in two years.
