

Windsor University School of Medicine, St Kitts *Not Accredited*

July 2017 Determination: *Not Accredited*

A visit was paid to Windsor University School of Medicine's campus in St Kitts and clinical affiliates in Chicago, September 19-24, 2016. This was the school's second accreditation exercise carried out by CAAM-HP.

The CAAM-HP at its meeting held July 20-22, 2017 considered and accepted the site visit report of the *ad hoc* assessment team comprising:

Decision: The Authority noted the good progress made in addressing the concerns identified in the 2014 site visit report and commended the use of the site visit report as the basis for the strategic plan. However, given that the programme was in transition in some critical areas, the Authority decided that it was unable to accredit the programme at that time.

July 2015 Update

The CAAM-HP at its meeting held July 23-25, 2014 noted the report of efforts being made to address the issues in the letter of July 28, 2014 and in particular the appointment of a new dean. The meeting noted that there was a number of critical areas outlined in the aforementioned letter that still needed to be addressed and strongly recommended the appointment of a senior physician in the school's administration. CAAM-HP looks forward to the full site visit in 2016.

July 2014 Determination: *Not Accredited*

It has been brought to the attention of the CAAM-HP Secretariat that reports have been circulating that Windsor University School of Medicine in St Kitts has been accredited or provisionally accredited by CAAM-HP. The CAAM-HP wishes to advise that Windsor University School of Medicine is not accredited by the CAAM-HP. The site visit took place in March 2014 and, after consideration of the site visit report, CAAM-HP in July 2014 determined

that it could not accord accreditation to the programme. The school was asked to reapply for accreditation in two years.
